

CALL FOR PAPERS & POSTERS

The Program Committee of the International Seafood & Health Conference and Exhibition encourages the submission of high quality abstracts for oral and poster presentations. All abstracts must be in **English** – the official language of the conference.

Authors are strongly encouraged to consider poster presentations as these will be an integral part of the conference program. Papers submitted for “oral presentation only” may not be accepted as oral presentations and if not offered for Posters will be rejected. All abstract presenters selected for an oral presentation will be contacted by the relevant Theme Leader and will have a presentation time allotted.

Authors of studies involving proprietary products or formulations should present this information at the exhibition or contact us regarding workshop opportunities.

All presenters are required to pay their own registration, accommodation and travel expenses. Registration will be guaranteed at Super Early Bird Rates. A USB Abstract Book will be given to registered delegates.

The conference program committee is making a Call for Papers and Posters for the important International Seafood & Health Conference which has the overall theme of:

“Creating a paradigm shift” Seafood: Benefiting Health and Wellbeing

The conference program committees are seeking to deliver to the audience the latest science, research and information in the following streams and themes:

- **Health, Nutrition and Medical Science & Research – “Seafood: The Essential Ingredient for Health and Wellbeing”**
- **Food Security and Sustainability – “Oceans for Health”**
- **Human Behaviour and Communications – “Seafood for Life”**

The duration of each presentation is 20 minutes including question time. The conference program committee may approach authors to request changes in their proposals to better fit conference aims.

The organising committee is preparing a special issue in the journal “Frontiers in Biosciences” to cover outstanding and important research activities presented at this conference. The journal “Frontiers in Bioscience” is a peer reviewed modern forum for scientific communication covering the field of biology and biomedical sciences and is indexed e.g. by PubMed and BIOSIS. Article can include reviews and research articles in basic and applied sciences.
